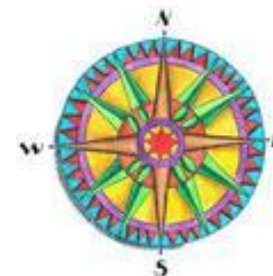
The annual membership fee of £5 is due in January.

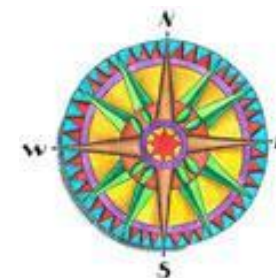
