Please share cars or use public transport where possible to reduce the number of cars parked at the beginning of walks. All walkers are asked to bring spare shoes if accepting lifts and to offer the driver a contribution towards the cost of fuel and car parking fees.. Please note that all distances are approximate and ascents are given as a guide to difficulty. Children are welcome, but under 18s must be accompanied by a parent or guardian on all walks. Dogs are usually welcome but must be on a short lead at all times (not an extending one for the safety of other walkers). There may be cattle or other livestock in fields and also stiles where you have to lift your dog. We will try to warn of this in advance but it may not always be possible. Please respect the walk leader's wishes and advice. All walkers are expected to wear footwear and clothing which is suitable for the route and weather conditions, and to bring their own food and drink when necessary. Walkers are responsible for their own health and safety. The annual membership fee of £7 is due on your 2nd walk with us, and on January 1st for subsequent years..
